When picking up children from aftercare, please park on Mesquite Street and enter campus through the iron gates by Knox Hall. Aftercare is available to all students from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m.. Those leaving by 4:30 p.m. are charged \$100 a month while those staying after 4:30 p.m. are \$200 a month. Daily drop in rates are \$15 a day.
